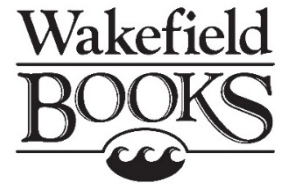

RE: Bookfairs

We are a locally-owned Independent Bookstore and we are proud to support local PTO's and schools with our bookfair program. We offer two ways of doing a bookfair, in-school, or in-store. Wakefield Books offers:

- Personalized service by a friendly and knowledgeable staff
- Great selection of books for all ages including new releases, old classics, and large children's section
- Many gift items such as puzzles, games, and toys
- Fast special ordering system – most books arrive in 3-5 days
- Teachers can receive a 20% classroom discount on purchases for their classroom
- We stock all of the summer reading list titles for your students including this year's RI Award Winners.
- Our Website is open 24/7, So family or friends out of town can shop and help the school during bookfairs.

How do in school bookfairs work?

We work with the school to determine the amount and type of books to bring as well as the venue where it will be run. Planning should begin at least a month ahead. We will deliver the books and pick up the remaining copies when it is over. We will provide a detailed list of titles brought along with instructions on pricing. The school will need to provide volunteers to handle the selling of the books, but the bookfair can run an entire week if needed. Schools are welcome to stop by the store at any time to replenish stock as well. We can also provide some display fixtures and credit card readers if requested. After pickup, we will calculate sales and invoice the school for the books sold minus 20% for the school. We have a database of proven sellers by grade which we update frequently.

How do in-store bookfairs work?

We will provide a voucher to your school for distribution and when presented at the register will give the school 20% of the sale (pre-tax) during the dates set. Present the voucher at the register or show us on your phone. This will count for all items sold in store, not just children's books. Our website www.wakefieldbooks.com is available 24/7 so anyone anywhere can participate. Just add "voucher" or the school's name in the comment field when you make a purchase and it will count for the school. This is a great way for family and friends out of town to help out and make it a big success!

Teachers also have the ability to create wish lists on our website. Once they create their free account, they can shop for the items they want and instead of adding each to a cart, they can create a wish list and add them to that. A link for the wish list can be copied and pasted into an email or on social media and it will also be searchable on the website by name. There is a link at the top of our home page for wish lists. As items are purchased, the list will update so there will be no duplicates, much like a gift registry.
